#### **Tuesday Sept 11 Bike Tour**



The Riva del Garda area is known for some superb bicycle trails and an abundance of eBike rentals. Since eBikes cost between 40 and 60 euros for one day and are not rented hourly we would like to plan a whole day with lots of refreshment spots

Our guide will be former Giro d'Italia professional cyclist Denis Bertolini. Denis is a local legend and speaks fluent English. He has guided many tour in the area. Denis stays on protected bicycle trails





We will start in Loppio and make our way around the nature preserve towards Nago and then Arco. We will stop at the Roman bridge crossing the Sarca river

Then down to Riva and some spectacular photo ops!



For safety reasons we will then transport the eBikes and riders to Limone. We will walk our bikes thru Limone and stop for group pictures and shopping. We will ride the "Cyclabile del Garda" trail that is suspended on the side of the mountain overlooking Lake Garda. Prepare for some spectacular views. We will walk our bikes thru Limone and you will have some time to shop. We will stop at appropriate points for group photos.





Then back on the support vehicle and a safe drive back to Riva where we will pedal to Toborle and Malcesine on the protected bicycle path

Finally we will make our way back to our starting location of Loppio

There will be many stops for refreshments, food and awesome pictures. The eBikes have enough power to last the whole day. All you need to do is gentle pedaling! ## **Lower Trentino Wine Tour**

We will visit the Cantina Grigoli in Mori. Since 1800, the Grigolli family has passed down the farming

tradition and viticulture by raising cattle with the production of cheese and butter, cultivating wheat and tobacco and producing wine for family use only. The oenologist Bruno Grigolli today tells this story through his wines,

enhancing the territory in which he lives, the classic vines, the climate and the winemaking practices transmitted with great passion from generation to generation.





**Armando Simoncelli** decided to start making wine from the grapes from his own vineyards in 1977 and to bottle with his own name on the label.

The company is based in 'Navesel', an ancient port on the Adige river, just south west of Rovereto, in

Vallalagarina. With the reclamation of the valley floor and the embankment of the river, a fertile countryside remained where

the vineyards found an ideal

environment to develop and produce superior quality grapes. The Simoncelli family began cultivating those vineyards more than two hundred years ago and the farmhouse that stands in the center of them, renovated and enlarged in 1985, houses the winemaking and wine aging cellar. ### **Brentonico and Castione Thursday September 12**

Meet at the cemetery in Besagno at 10 on Thursday September 12th. Besagno is 5 kms up the road to Brentonico from Mori. The Besagno cemetery is on your left on the right hand sharp curve on main road to Brentonico. There is lots of parking to the left of the cemetery,



We will meet Angelo Zeni and visit il Mulino Zeni which is unique in that all gears are made of wood. Of the over 1,000 historic mills in the Trentino area, used to grind cereals, the Mulino Zeni is one of the few still fully functional. Fundamental to the rural economy, the "Vitruvian" mill with palmenti was found almost everywhere in the Trentino valleys, near small and large waterways. Of the over a thousand mills that could be counted in this area around the nineteenth century, the Zeni Mill, built in 1806 by the Ballista family, is the only



one with hydraulic power still in operation in the Sorna Valley. Here, in the 19th century, around twenty mills, forges and sawmills were powered by water. The mill was purchased by the Zeni family in 1906. <u>Click here</u> for more details.



Lunch will be at the famous Maso Palu which specializes in km0 food. Camilla Girardelli and family will prepare some traditional Trentino food. The tasting menu changes frequently with what is available locally. There will be a presentation of the book Una Vita Con Entusiasmo, an autobiography of Augusto Girardelli, an extraordinary man who was responsible for much of what is now Altisimo and Monte Baldo, and a preview of the video documentary.

After lunch we will stop by Castione and meet Carlo Viesi of Vies Beer. Carlo has worked hard reintroducing ancient grains in Trentino agriculture. We will taste some craft beer made using these ancient grains Hopefully Carlo will have some of the famous Castione chestnuts left over and frozen from this year. He will cook some for us!





We will then visit the local church and see the famous Castione pink marble that was used in many churches of the Austrian Empire. Hungarian








A short hike from a panoramic view of the Stivo Mountain at an altitude of 1165 meters are caves called La Giazzera formed between large landslide boulders with characteristic that makes them unique. In summer, in the innermost parts, fair quantities of ice form and accumulate making for a natural refrigeration unit.

After lunch we will drive down to Pannone to see the ruins of the old mill and the roaring Dal Ri river.



Then a visit to Corniano and the abandoned ruins. Corniano, not far from Manzano, is a ghost town, abandoned perhaps following the reprisals of the Venetians, who in 1440 led to the destruction of the castles of Albano and Nomesino, perhaps following the great plague of 1630. The stone houses and ruins of the mysterious town and the overlying rocks colored by overlapping red and gray limestone layers, give rise to an environment so extraordinary that it has been included in the areas of monumental interest by the Province of Trento. The delightful Romanesque church of S. Agata, \stands alone in a panoramic position.



We end the day with a hike up Mt. Grom and the preserved Austrian trenches of Nagià Grom from World War 1. The Alpini

from Mori will share the history of the 360 degree fortifications The panorama alone is worth the 10 minute hike!




