
Congratulations Dottore Mosèr

Directions to STC 2013 Polenta Picnic Founders' Lodge Des Moines Beach Park

From the South - From I-5 Northbound, take the Des Moines exit (#149B) then to **"Continue"**.

From the North - From I-5 Southbound, take the Des Moines exit (#149) then to **"Continue"**.

Continue: Turn right and go straight through the light at Pacific Highway South (SR99) and continue down Kent Des Moines Road to the light at Marine View Drive (Taco Time/ Brown Bear Car Wash). Turn right onto Marine View Drive and continue to South 223rd Street. Turn left onto 223rd Street South and follow it as it turns right and becomes Cliff Avenue South and stay right to enter the park. Follow the road, staying left as it makes a u-turn and heads back toward the water. The Founders' Lodge will be on your left. There is parking in that area, and at various other areas from the entrance of the park on. In the unlikely event that all parking is taken in the park, there is plenty in the Des Moines Marina parking lot, which you passed just before entering the park.
